To Our Parents & Guardians:

Kiefer & AFA families - I hope this email finds you well. I don't need to explain to you the challenging times we are facing as a school, community and nation. My staff and I have been reaching out to you on an individual basis to update you on learning, well-being, and to communicate any school information.

The governor has issued a new executive stay at home order until April 8th. Please remember that spring break is this week from March 23rd - March 27th. There will be no home learning activities during that week. Home learning will continue on Monday, March 30th. This means we will be providing home learning for our students through April 7th, with a current plan to return to school on April 8th. This of course could always change. Your teacher should have reached out to you recently to arrange a plan for these learning activities. Again, please visit www.chail.org for any community meal programs in your area.

Any scheduled special education meetings (annual reviews, etc.) will continue as scheduled. An administrator will be reaching out to you to confirm this meeting. Until further notice, this meeting will occur through a digital format or phone call amongst the IEP team.

As noted in your phone calls with your student's teacher, we are always accessible. Please reach out as needed. School therapists, teachers, and all school personnel are in constant communication about students as we navigate these unique circumstances.

Finally, the Administration team at Kiefer and AFA have created a Remind Class for all of you to join. You do not need the Remind App on your phone. You simply need to follow the directions below and you will receive text messages that pertain to school updates. You will not be flooded with text messages.
